

## FIRST

Use questions that will help you determine where God is working.

- 1 What are your spiritual beliefs?
- 2 In your opinion, who is Jesus?
- 3 Is there such a thing as a heaven and a hell?
- 4 Where do you think you will go when you die? Why?
- 5 If you discovered that what you believe in isn't really true, would you want to know what IS true?

If they say “Yes,” to your last question, then go to Step Two. If they say “No,” then they will not be open to the gospel. So you can thank them for sharing and change the subject.

## SECOND

Let the Holy Spirit do the convicting, convincing, and teaching through His Word. Ask the person to read aloud the verses you have underlined. Ask them, “What does this verse say to you?”

- 1 Romans 3:23 – “For all have sinned.”
- 2 Romans 6:23 – “For the wages of sin is death.”
- 3 Romans 5:8 – “But God proves His love for us
- 4 John 3:3 – “Unless someone is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.”
- 5 John 3:16 – “For God so loved the world.”
- 6 John 14:6 – “I am the way.”
- 7 John 1:12 – “But as many as received Him.”
- 8 Romans 10:9-11 – “If you confess, you will be saved.”
- 9 2 Corinthians 5:15 – “No longer live for themselves.”
- 10 I Corinthians 15:3-4 – “Christ died for our sins.”
- 11 Ephesians 2: 8, 9 – “For by grace are you saved.”
- 12 Revelation 3:20 – “I stand at the door and knock.”

Listen carefully to what they say. Do not allow yourself to argue if they disagree with the scriptures. If they say they agree the verses are true, then lead them to Christ.

## THIRD

Ask them some key questions to help them choose Jesus for salvation.

- 1 So, do you believe you have ever sinned against God?
- 2 Do you want God to forgive you of your sins?
- 3 Do you believe Jesus really died for you and is alive in Heaven, as He said?
- 4 Do you want to pray to Jesus and ask him to come into your life?

While you talk to and listen to this person, you should be silently praying. Now you can ask this person to pray. If they don't feel like praying aloud by themselves, lead them in prayer.

When you use these steps to share Jesus, you let the Holy Spirit work in the person's heart and life.
